


THERE ARE 2 WAYS TO JOIN

Our annual budget is \$100,000. Much of this cost comes from transportation and lodging, which is born directly by the volunteers. However the cost of supplies, medications and equipment comes from our fundraising. All funds go directly to the project. There are no paid employees in the Flying Samaritans Arizona.
